ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE PLATTED  
CITY LIMITS.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARBA DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Established Speed Limit.

The City Council adopted a speed limit of 15 miles per hour on all City streets, roads and avenues within the platted area of the City at the special public meeting held June 15, 2010.

Section 2. Signage.


Two 15 mph speed limit signs shall be posted within the platted area of the City – one to be posted on the south side and one to be posted on the north side of the City.

Section 3. Violation.

Violation of the speed limit is to be reported to the Itasca County Sheriff's Department. Citations, if deemed appropriate, will be issued by the responding Deputy and the penalty will be issued either through Citation and fine or the Court system as deemed appropriate by the responding Deputy.

This Ordinance shall be adopted into the Warba City Code and shall be in full force and effect upon the date of publication.
